#### <u>HOTELS</u>

• This Package doesn't offer city center hotels. Hotels will be located in the airport area or on the outskirts as a 3rd person in a triple room, most hotels offer roll-away beds & room size will be the same as double room

• For Child with bed: At times hotel don't have enough roll-away beds, in that case they might give a double & a separate single room

• A person 12 years & below is considered child & above 12 years, an adult

• Hotel rooms may not be air conditioned / air cooled nor will fans be provided. Air conditioning / cooling in hotels are set as per European weather conditions

• Functioning of Air cooling / Air conditioning in hotels is subject to official declaration of summer by the local authority

• Due to international events & trade fairs you may have to stay in hotels further away from the city
